


How Pure Must a Church Leader Be?

- How do you recognize a leader with integrity?
- How "blameless" is blameless?
- Character flaws revealed by repeated sinfulness may disqualify person from high-profile leadership
- Selecting a small trustworthy group to whom we can safely expose our inner being




- How can you determine whether a potential leader is a person of integrity?



- 11. Is obedience in small matters built into my reflexes?
- 12. Do I have joy?




