As a church family our sense of mission stretches beyond our community and even beyond our land. We have an interest in Christian work in various world locations. (See separate page).

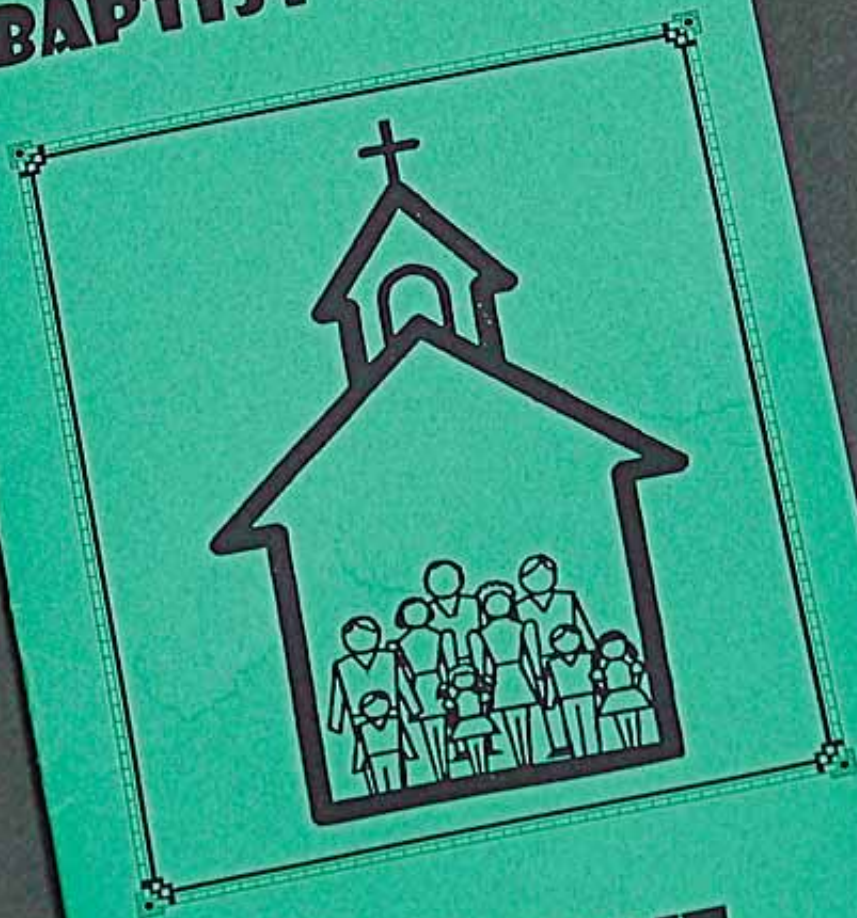
Love Link

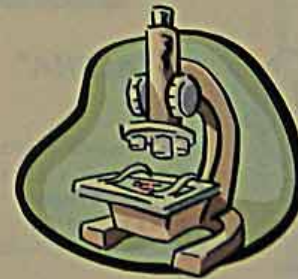

KEEPING OUR VALUED UNITY

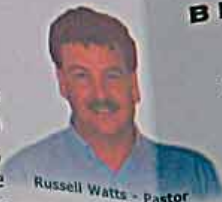
We invite you to test everything taught in this church not against your opinion, experience or tradition but against the Bible.

We believe that our church buildings will need to be expanded and re-organised to facilitate:

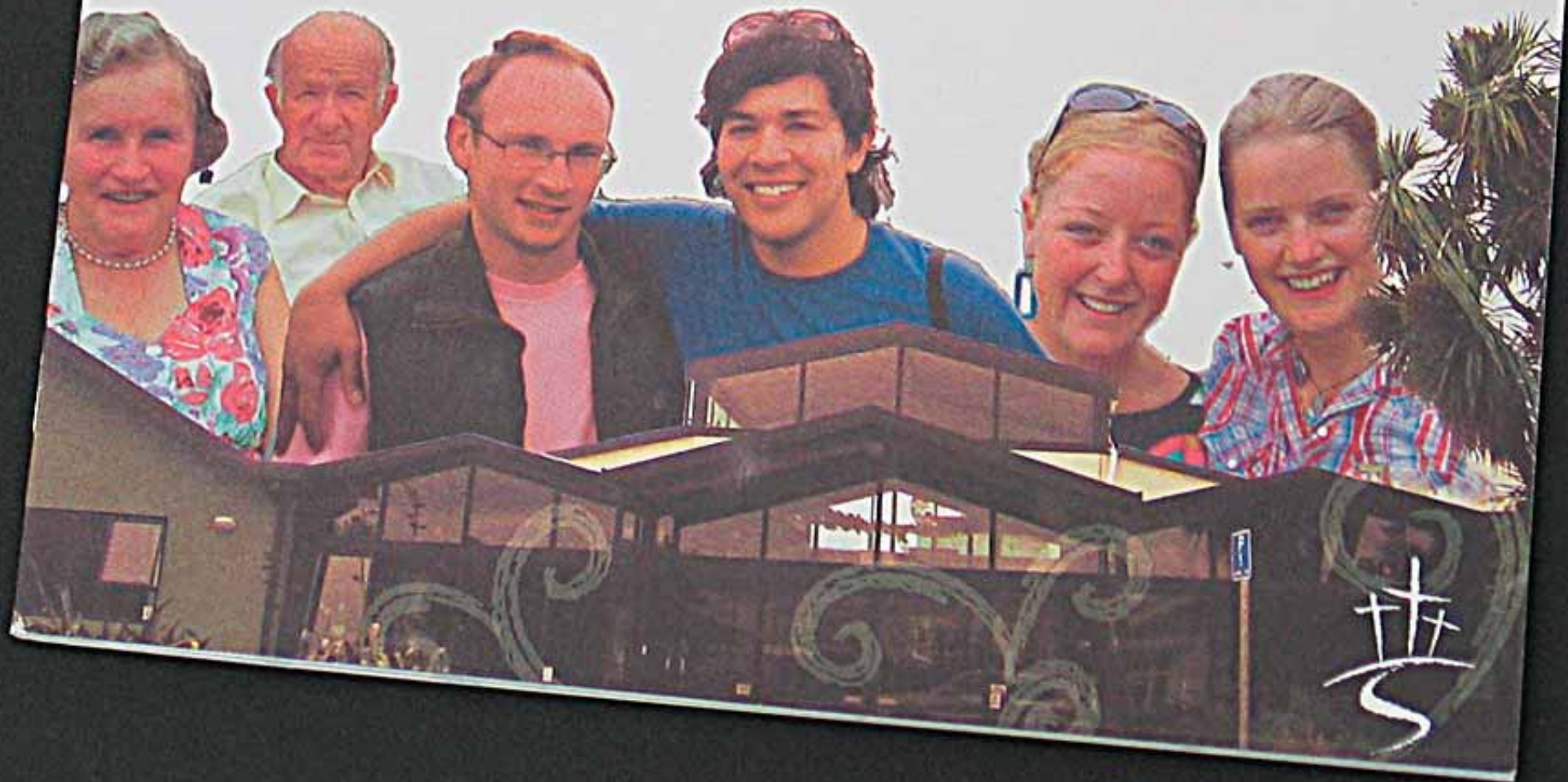
1. 300 worshippers at each service

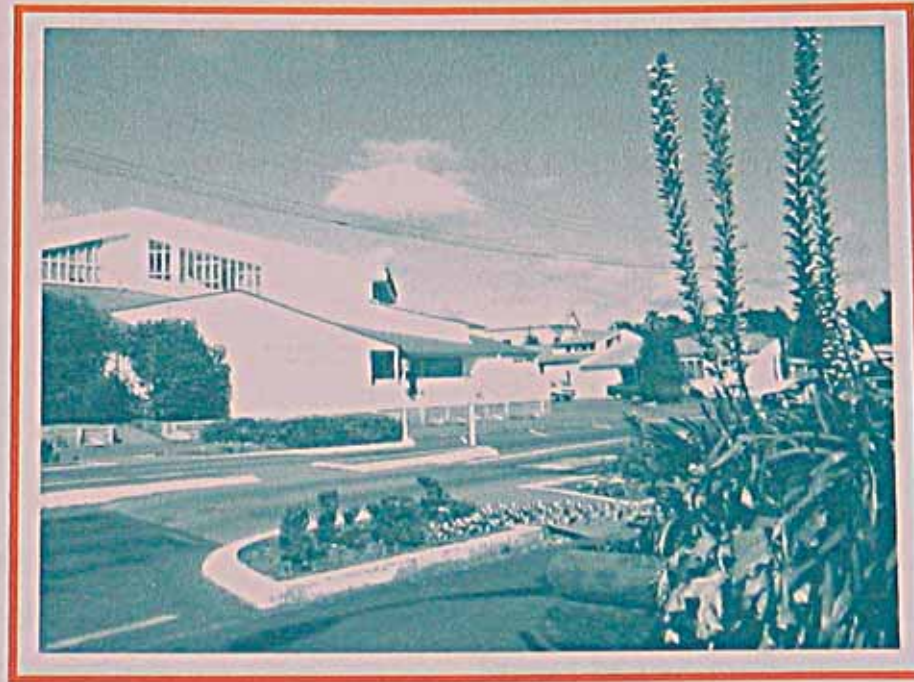

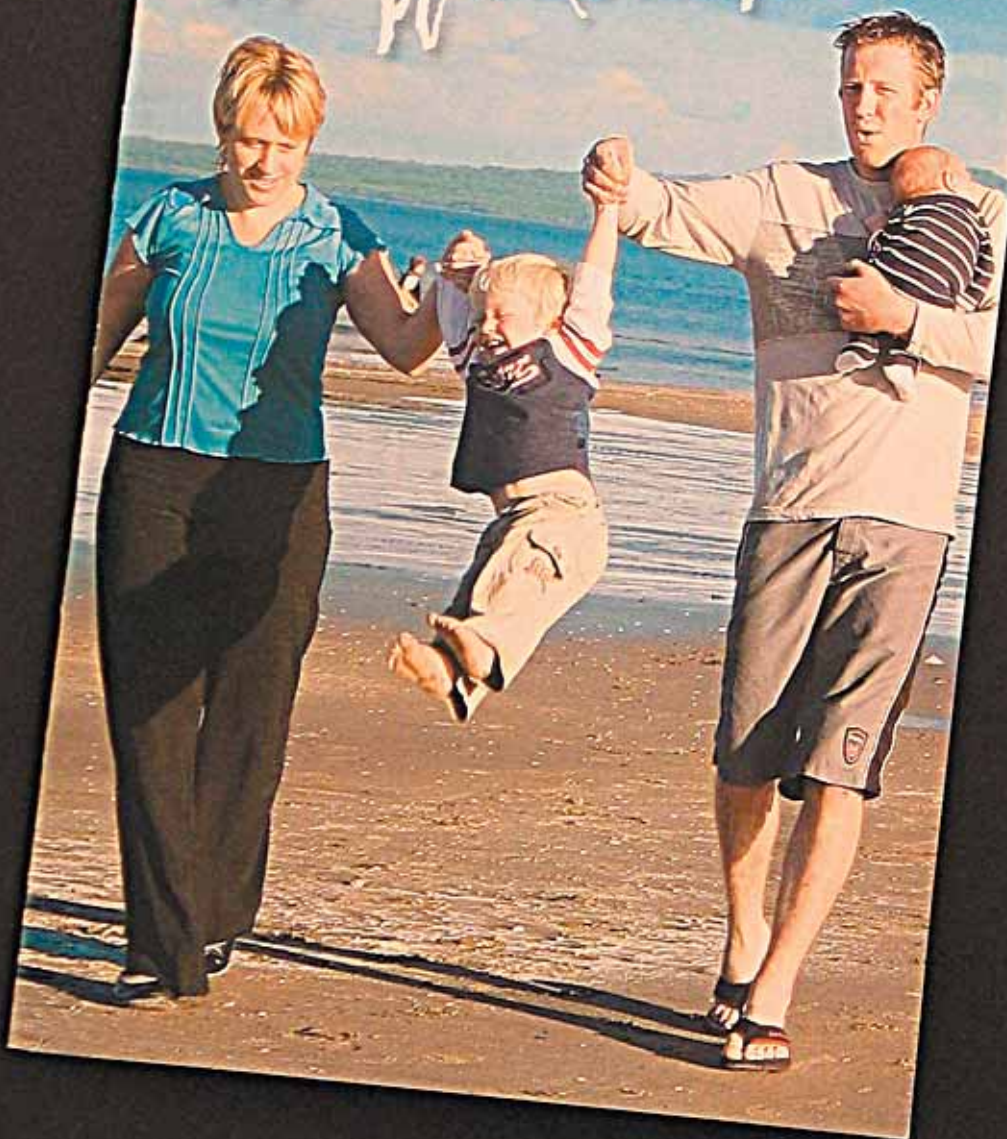

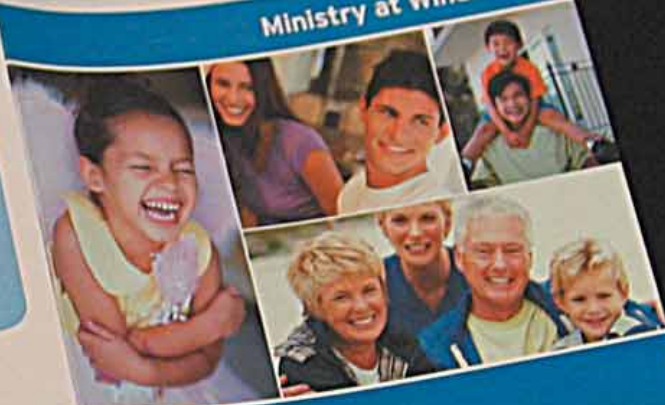
